
Landscape Tent Calendar


Bleed (3mm)

The bleed area extends 5mm beyond the edge of your finished document. Colours and images must extend beyond the edge of the document to prevent unwanted white borders around the edge of your finished document. Note that this 'bleed' will be trimmed during the finishing process so ensure that no important details are set up to print in this area.

Safe Area (5mm)

It is recommended that your artwork is at least 5mm from the edge of the page if it is not meant to bleed off. Printed borders placed too close to the edge of a page may look uneven when the job is trimmed.





Tips for using our Template

If you choose to use our pre-populated template, here are a few tips to help you make the most of it:

- Ensure you export your artwork as 'spreads' instead of pages.
- Don't put anything important in the Tape Flap as this will not be visible
- Don't forget to make sure the template isn't visible on your finished artwork the bottom layer is set to 'non-printing' by default.
- The PDFs are just for reference they are not editable. For fully editable artwork we have InDesign and Illustrator templates available.
